## **2.1 JUST DO IT**

- **Fan-**someone who likes a particular sport or performing art very much, or who admires a famous person
- **Referee-**someone who makes sure that the rules of a sport such as football, basketball, or boxing, are followed
- **Spectator-** someone who is watching an event or game
- **Team-mate-**someone who belongs to the same team as you
- Opponent-someone who you try to defeat in a competition, game, fight, or argument
- Coach-someone who trains a person or team in a sport
- **Athlete-**someone who competes in sports competitions, especially running, jumping, and throwing
- Pitch-a marked out area of ground on which a sport is played, football/cricket/rugby
- Resort-a place where a lot of people go for holidays, seaside/beach/ski etc resort
- Court-an area made for playing games such as tennis, squash/tennis/basketball etc court
- Rink-a specially prepared area of ice that you can skate on, ice rink
- Ring-a small square area surrounded by ropes, where people box or wrestle
- **Cricket-**a game between two teams of 11 players in which players try to get points by hitting a ball and running between two sets of three sticks
- **Squash-**a game played by two people who use rackets to hit a small rubber ball against the walls of a square court
- **Bounce-**to move up and down, especially because you are hitting a surface that is made of rubber
- Club-a long thin metal stick used in golf to hit the ball
- **Bat-**a long wooden stick with a special shape that is used in some sports and games, cricket, baseball
- Bat-a round flat piece of wood with a handle, used to hit a ball in table tennis
- Stick-a long, specially shaped piece of wood, plastic etc that you use in some sports to hit a ball, hockey
- **Beat-**to get the most points, votes etc in a game, race, or competition, defeat
- Score-to win a point in a sport, game, competition, or test
